


### **CARLISLE VINEYARD VARIETIES:**

Mike Officer has meticulously mapped out every vine in the Carlisle Vineyard and has identified 43 different varieties to date.


Because some of the varieties are so unusual, Mike had genetic testing done to determine what they were. Some of these varieties have not likely been identified in any other vineyards in the U.S.


# PEDIGREED GROWERS & OLD-VINE FRUIT


### **OLD-VINE "GROUND ZERO"**




# MARQUEE OLD-VINE VINEYARDS

RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY | PINER-OLIVET SUB-REGION






